Native Fish Keepers, Inc. is currently accepting letters of interest for two (2) vacancies on the Board of Directors. Both are for three (3) years. The purpose of the corporation is to make mitigation and fish conservation efforts on Flathead Lake financially sustainable.

Individuals appointed to the board must have expertise in the field of business, commercial fish or food preparation and sales. Must have interest in the native fisheries resources of the Flathead Reservation and Flathead Lake and have expertise in the field of fisheries or related natural resources and be an enrolled CSKT member.

Tribal Council policy adopted in March 2007 states:

Any Tribal employee serving on a board or committee that is not directly related to the position the person holds in the Tribal organization, is required to use leave or leave-without-pay to attend all meetings, participate in any activity associated with the board or committee, or for any travel related to the board or committee. Tribal employees are restricted to serving on no more than one (1) board at any time."
